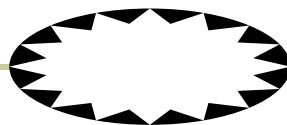

What do Lifesavers, grape jelly, Kool-Aid, toothpaste, wine and laundry detergent have in common? No, they are not all edible. If you said that all are water soluble, you're correct. A substance that dissolves in water, dissipates in water or mixes thoroughly with water is water soluble. In artists' materials a number of painting mediums fall within this category: Watercolor, Gouache, Tempera, Egg tempera, Casein, Acrylic and Inks. Just like grape jelly and laundry detergent are used for different reasons, each water-based medium has unique properties making its use more desirable to reach the final result.
